excise tax	a tax by the government on the manufacture, sale, or use of certain products  Examples: gasoline, luxury cars, alcohol, tobacco
government revenue	. tax dollars received by government
income tax	a tax on earned income that is paid to a local, state, or national government
progressive tax	a tax that increases as income level increases  Example: federal income tax
property tax	a tax paid on the assessed value of land and buildings
proportional tax	a tax that takes the same percentage in taxes from all income levels  Example: sales tax
regressive tax	a tax that takes a higher percentage from lower income levels than higher incomes  Example: Social Security
sales tax	taxes paid on some goods or services purchased; based on a percentage of the selling price
