baleen whales whales without teeth but with rows of whalebone plates that act as a sieve for feeding

Example: blue whale

blowhole opening located on the top of the head

of whales and dolphins, used for

obtaining oxygen

blubber the fat of marine animals, which is used

to keep the animal warm

echolocation use of sounds to locate objects

endangered in danger of extinction due to natural or

manmade factors

flippers front limbs of dolphins, other whales,

and seals; used for balancing and

steering

fluke tail fin of whales, including dolphins

melon fatty area on the forehead of whales,

including dolphins, that controls the reception of pulses and echolocation

moratorium a legal ban; a legally authorized period

of delay

toothed whales whales which have teeth

Examples: sperm whale, dolphin
