mass the amount of matter in a substance matter anything that has both mass and volume **melting point** the temperature at which a solid turns to liquid **phase** one of the states of matter of a substance (H₂O occurs in three phases: ice, liquid water, and water vapor.) **physical properties** the qualities of matter that can be observed without changing the matter (color, shape, size, density) plasma the form of matter in stars; this is usually gaseous matter under extreme heat and pressure reacts changes in response to something **solid** the form of matter that has a definite shape and volume state the condition of matter **volume** the amount of space that matter takes up weight the force of gravity on an object
