| compound     | a substance formed when two or more elements combine chemically   |

| element      | a substance that cannot be broken down into a simpler form by ordinary chemical means   |
| formula      | the way a chemist tells how two or more elements are combined to make a compound <i>Example</i> : H <sub>2</sub> O is the formula for water |
| hydrogen (H) | the lightest and most abundant of all elements; occurs as a gas when not in other substances  |
| mixtures     | two or more substances put together; no<br>chemical reaction takes place and they<br>are easily separated                                   |
| oxygen (O)   | an element found as a gas when not in<br>other substances; it has an atomic<br>number of eight and is involved in<br>burning and rusting    |
| symbols      | the letters used by scientists to represent the names of the elements   |
