


•	. segregated unit of Japanese Americans which fought heroically in Italy and France
appeasement	. giving in to demands to avoid conflict
blitzkrieg	. a war conducted with great speed and force
campaign	. a series of military moves carried out to achieve a specific goal
concentration camps	prisons operated by Nazi Germany in which Jews and other groups considered to be enemies of Adolf Hitler were starved while doing slave labor or were tortured and murdered
death camps	. Nazi extermination centers where Jews and non-Jews were brought to be put to death as part of Hitler's Final Solution
defensive	. protecting against attack or aggression
fleet	. a number of warships under one command
fortification	. a structure (like a fort) for defending against an attack

liberate to set free

retreat to pull back; to withdraw

rubble broken fragments from destroyed buildings and other structures and left in piles
